SYNOPSIS

The symbol of prosperity and order, Hong Kong's Central district is about to become a fiery purgatory.

Thirty years ago, a family was brutally murdered. As pained cries echo from a refugee boat, the perpetrators laugh shamelessly. The patriarch's sacrifice rewrites the fate of two brothers and sparks a flame of hatred that would burn for decades. Unfortunately, not only does the perpetrator - **Rupert Cheuk** (Michael HUI) - escape justice; he is reborn as a respected man of good social standing.

Seeing his father's killer rise to power, surviving son **Chi-long** (Andy LAU) changes his name and reinvents himself to become Rupert's right-hand man.

However, Chi-long's brother **Chi-chau** (Nicholas TSE) also survived the massacre, but he ended up in a foreign land and became a mercenary. Raised in a ruthless world of bloodshed, Chi-chau became a man who always acts on his raw feelings, whether it be love or hate. He doesn't spare a thought for right or wrong. To him, revenge is no complex matter; there is only action or inaction, to kill to not to kill.

Though both men are seeking revenge for the same crime, whose method is "right"?

When Chi-chau returns to Hong Kong, not only are Cheuk's best-laid plans derailed; Chi-chau turns Hong Kong Island into a battlefield. As Chi-chau takes brutal revenge on his family's murderers one by one, Chi-long finds himself forced to protect Cheuk because of his job.

Two brothers are caught in a cycle of hate as Hong Kong burns in a violent inferno. As Chi-chau pushes further, what does Chi-long have to do to stop this blaze of hatred from spreading?

SYNOPSIS

SYNOPSIS

The film "A Man and A Woman" depicts an absurdly comedic encounter between two strangers brought together by chance. In adjacent hotel rooms separated by a single wall, two adults trapped by life's burdens - each carrying private sorrows never shown to the world - connect across the divide through makeshift communication methods. Through misunderstandings and conflicts, empathy and revelations, they gradually form an unlikely bond that heals each other's emotional wounds.

Yet this transient connection must eventually yield to reality's call, summoning them back to their predetermined life trajectories. As existence unfolds through an endless chain of choices, where will their paths ultimately lead?

This bittersweet romantic comedy shines with vivid observations of contemporary life and distinctly Chinese humor. Every viewer will find reflections of themselves - the ambitious dreamer, the defeated soul nearly surrendering to despair, the enlightened survivor of life's irreversible farewells. Amidst the overwhelming trivialities and existential sighs of adulthood, the film reveals humanity's tender compassion and kindles warm embers of hope.

SYNOPSIS

Mui (Fish Liew) was born with mild cerebral palsy. For her past 20-odd years on earth, Mui has merely been surviving, not living. Everything in her life is about convenience; she has never even put on makeup or dressed up, let alone fall in love. When Mui learns that her mother will make her get a hysterectomy to get rid of her menstruation, she realizes that she will never be a “woman” again.

Recommended by her disabled friend Joe, Mui goes to **Eva** (Polly LAU). Like White Gloves in Japan and Hand Angel in Taiwan, Eva's non-profit volunteer organization provides sexual services for the disabled. For Mui, who cannot discuss anything about love or desire with her staunchly conservative mother, Eva's organization is a blessing in disguise.

It turns out that Mui's volunteer is **Ken** (Carlos Chan), a motorcycle rider whom Mui sees every day on the bus. At their first meeting, Mui feels the care and respect that she has never felt in her life. Even though she was too nervous to finish the deed, she finds herself emotionally attached - even infatuated - to Ken.

However, Ken is far from perfect himself. He chose to become a volunteer to help the disabled because he watched his late sister suffer in depression after a traffic accident left her crippled. Since her death, Ken has been living aimlessly, working bit jobs and refusing to commit to relationships. When he finds himself developing feelings for Mui, he tries to shut them down. Ken convinces himself that he only provides a service with no strings attached.

As Mui finds herself flourishing from the emotional and physical liberation brought on by Ken, Mui's over-protective mother responds by tightening her emotional leash around her daughter. Will Mui finally achieve the emancipation she has been seeking all her life?

SYNOPSIS

One night in the urban jungle, the Yuen brothers- **Dragon** (Louis CHEUNG), **Shia** and **Mo** (Andy ON) - are preparing for another heist. Meanwhile, the East Kowloon Regional Crime Unit - led by **Ben Cheng** (Alex FONG) - lurks nearby, ready to scoop the Yuens up once they determine the thieves' next target. Embedded among the thieves is **Bong Chan**, Ben's undercover agent.

When the Yuens suddenly change their plans, the hot-headed Ben goes against his superior's orders and leads a raid, but the ensuing firefight leaves Bong dead and Ben's colleagues gravely injured. For his misjudgment, Ben is demoted from the RCU. The Yuen brothers escape, but Shia dies from his injuries. The surviving brothers swear revenge.

Three years pass. Ben is now the sergeant of Emergency Unit Car 3. He now plays by the book and simply wants to get to the end of the day without any fuss. One day, **Wallace** (Carlos CHAN) - Bong's younger brother - is assigned to Car 3 by chance. Still feeling guilty over Bong's death, Ben acts awkwardly around Wallace.

An earnest young rookie, Wallace is eager to go above and beyond his duties, but Ben insists on sticking to protocols and never straying from Car 3's patrol route. Frustrated, Wallace follows Ben after work and discovers that Ben actually cares more about the people he helps than he seems, but he still blames himself for Bong's death.

Meanwhile, Dragon and Mo have returned to Hong Kong. The two pull a series of daring armed robberies, but they are after more than just money- they're back to avenge the death of their brother. Wallace becomes obsessed with catching the Yuens to avenge Bong, even at the risk of losing his job and his life. To stop Wallace from following in his brother's footsteps, Ben calls in his former colleagues for one last fight.
